CONTRACTOR CORE WORKFORCE FORM

San Diego County Water Authority Project Labor Agreement

Article 4, Section 4.6 of the San Diego County Water Authority ("Water Authority") Project Labor Agreement ("PLA") requires Contractors who are not directly signatory to an applicable Master Agreement to provide a list of Core Employees to the Project Labor Coordinator and applicable Union, prior to the performance of Covered Work by such Core Employees. After submitting the list of Core Employees, Contractors shall not make any changes or substitutions to the Core Employees identified on such list for the duration of the Covered Project, except in cases where a Core Employee is injured or is otherwise unable to perform work on the Covered Project for a reason beyond the Contractor's control. Failure to submit the list of Core Employees for 30 calendar days after the list is provided to the Project Labor Coordinator and applicable Union.

In accordance with the Water Authority PLA, Article 4, Section 4.6, a worker must satisfy each of the following three (3) conditions in order to qualify as a Core Employee:

- a. Be either a journeyperson or apprentice;
- b. Be on Contractor's active payroll for at least sixty (60) of the last one-hundred-twenty (120) working days prior to being designated as a Core Employee; and
- c. Possess the applicable license required by state or federal law in order to perform work on the Covered Project

Please see Article 4.6 of the Water Authority PLA for additional information regarding use of Core Employees, including, but not limited to, the limitations on the use of such workers and the order of referrals of such workers.
